Due to the significant increase in the number of visitors for Eid there will be traffic delays in and around Handsworth Cemetery.

AMENDED HOURS OF OPERATION ON SAT 23rd, SUN 24th and MON 25th MAY:

9am to 12 noon -- Funeral Directors only for Burials
12 noon to 8pm - Bereaved families & Public access

WHAT TO DO



Please follow the signage and advice given by cemetery staff, security officers and volunteers.



Please ensure that you are aware of the area you need to visit before entering the cemetery.



Please adhere to the One Way System. The entrance will be from Oxhill Road and the exit from Camp Lane (West Bromwich side).



Please be respectful to everyone in the cemetery.



Please be patient – we expect a large number of visitors and you may be waiting in traffic during your visit.



Wherever possible, we request that visitors share vehicles or park on the outskirts of the cemetery in order to ease congestion.

PLEASE DO NOT - park on the grass verges.
 - block roads for other users.

Please be aware that there will be periods when vehicles are not permitted into the cemetery in order to allow the cemetery to clear before allowing more cars to enter.
